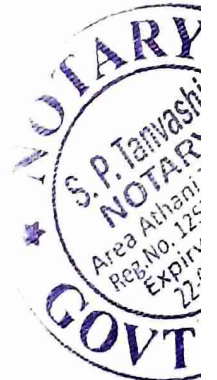
Conditions :

1. The school has been registered under the Child Rights Education Act - 2009, and the Karnataka Education Act-1983 and the rules framed there under and the Recognition has been renewed up to the class of the registered school. [Primary Education /Higher Education) 1 to 5th [1 to 5, 1 to 8, 6 to 8, 9 and 10 and 1 to 10] in addition to classes in these Schools, conducting Classes and Sections is not allowed.
2. The College shall function under the rules framed under the Karnataka Education Act-1983 and the Child Rights Education Act-2009.
3. Child Rights to Education Act-2009 under the rules framed there under to reserve 25% seats for weaker section children. the government is authorized to register under RTI the reserved seats for schools covered by RTE. [Government has formulated rules to facilitate the enrollment of



children in neighboring schools where their parents live, according to which, if there are government and government-funded educational institutions, children will be enrolled in that school] Otherwise, private schools will enroll children enrolled by the government and allow them to continue their education up to the primary level. To enable these children to continue their studies without any discrimination,

4. As explained in Annexure 3, the Government releases the fees of the children registered under the RTI Act as per the rules and therefore prohibits the collection of any fees from the children.
5. The school and the school management are prohibited from collecting any kind of capitation fee and voluntary donations from the parents either at the time of enrollment or thereafter.
6. The school/governing body shall publish information on the fees collected from the parents of the children in their school as tuition fee as per State Government Notification No: ED:31:PGC 2019, dated : 27-07-2019 on the departmental website and on the school notice board, no additional fee shall be charged over and above the prescribed fee.
7. The School / Governing Body shall enroll the students within the period fixed by the Govt.
8. The school / governing body cannot refuse enrollment against the following points.
 - (i) Due to lack of proof of Age.
 - (ii) On the basis of caste, religion, place of birth, language
 - (iii) If entry is sought after extended period of entry.
9. As per RTE Act and Rules and Karnataka Education Act and Rules Carrying out all safety measures (fire safety and building safety measures from concerned authorities) all Safety of Children's Learning as per K.S.C.P.C.R. and N.C.P.C.R.
10. The School Governing Board is as follows -
 - (i) No admitted child shall be retained in any Class or expelled from the school till he completes primary and secondary education in the School.
 - (ii) No child shall be subjected to physical or mental abuse.
 - (iii) No child shall be required to pass any board examination till completion of primary education.
 - (iv) Every child who completes primary education is issued a certificate as prescribed under RTE Rule-21 and Karnataka Education RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
 - (v) According to the provisions of the RTE Act and Rules and Karnataka Education Act and Rules Regulations, the school for children with special needs / special children even should be included.
 - (vi) Associate teachers shall possess the minimum qualifications not prescribed for primary and high school teachers in the RTE Act and Rules and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and Government Orders.



- vi) Salaries and allowances payable to teachers and service rules and allowances shall be as prescribed by the State Government and Government Notification (Prospective Fund (PF)) and the salaries paid to such teachers, and shall be subject to Employee State Insurance (ESI).
- (vii) Teachers shall perform the duties prescribed under Section-24 [1] of the Act and RTE Act and Rules as well as Rule-17 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules and shall not engage in private tuitions for supervised assessments.
11. To follow the syllabus and text books of the educational authority with which the school is affiliated.
12. The school shall enroll the students according to the facilities available in the school except as mentioned in Section-19 of the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
13. The School shall maintain rules and standards as specified in Section - 19. Appointment of remedial staff as prescribed in the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
14. Class / Sections (Branch) should not be opened unauthorized in or outside the school premises.
15. No commercial activities or political and non-academic activities during the day or night in the school buildings and other basic facilities entrusted to the school.
16. The school shall not be run for the benefit of any person or group or association.
17. Get the school audited by a Chartered Accountant and submit the copy to the Deputy Director / Field Education Officer by the end of June every year.
18. The School shall follow the Language Policy as per Government Notification [Kannada Language Policy-2016].
19. R.T.E. The Governing Body and Teachers shall act as per the Act and the Karnataka Education Act and Rules.
20. The School / Governing Body shall strictly follow the rules and directives of the Government and the Department.
21. Mandatory regular updating of school information in S.A.T.S. by the end of March every year.
22. Violation of the above terms will result in cancellation of accreditation of the school in accordance with the rules framed under the RTE Act, 2009 and the Karnataka Education Act, 1983.



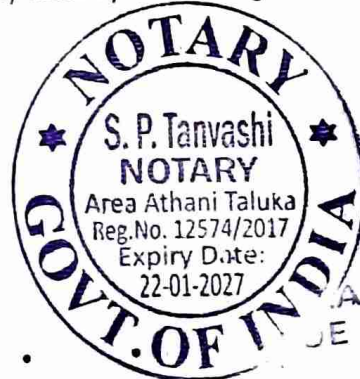
